APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete application provided with this letter (incomplete applications will not be considered). We must receive one application ***per camper, per season*** (receiving funds one season does not imply camperships will be awarded in future seasons).
2. Mail application to: **Redwood Glen, 100 Wright Drive, Loma Mar, CA 94021**
3. If applicable, a Redwood Glen representative may contact applicable churches for a verification status of church support.
4. You will be notified within two weeks of your application status. Applicants selected to receive campership funds will be provided further information on how to register for camp and receive their awarded amount. **In most cases, the non-refundable deposit will still be required. Please note: awarded funds are dispersed in the form of reductions of camp fees – no money will actually exchange hands.**

AVAILABILITY & GUIDELINES

Redwood Glen's ability to supply financial assistance is based on several factors. Funds will be made available based on, but not limited to, the following list:

- Availability of Funds
- Camper Need
- Order of Applications Received
- Priority is given to funds requested for attendance to a children's/youth camp.

General Guidelines:

1. Campership funds will be awarded for one camp session per season.
2. Campership funds may not be requested for any camper that will be attending a program camp during the same season at Redwood Glen or any other camp facility.
3. Redwood Glen respects your privacy. The information in this document will be treated as confidential unless otherwise noted (see paragraph in application signature box).
4. Redwood Glen is committed to non-discrimination. We will not prioritize applications based on church affiliation, race, gender, or age.
